



COMMUNITY KOSHER MEALS PROGRAM

This collaborative partnership provides free hot Kosher meals to marginalized seniors in the Jewish community. 18,000 meals are provided annually to participants through home delivery and communal meals served at the Staenberg-Loup Jewish Community Center.

THE PARTNERSHIP

JEWISHcolorado

Administers the program and provides "gap" funding for program costs not secured elsewhere.



Subsidizes direct cost of food & transportation



Identifies clients/provides case management and logistics. Provides programming for seniors before or after congregational meals.



Donates space for the congregational meals three days a week.

Shalom Park

Prepares OU Kosher meals for the congregational meal site at the JCC.

\$40,000 will take 40 seniors off the wait list and allow us to serve all seniors in need

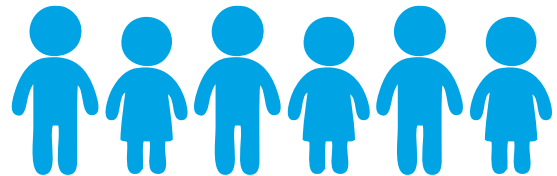
